COMMUNITY-BASED

Known as our "traditional" mentoring program, volunteer mentors spend a minimum of four hours per month with their mentee, many going above and beyond, teaching them new skills and hobbies, providing a friendship that will last a lifetime, and helping them reach their goals.

CANCER CARE PILOT PROGRAM

Cancer not only affects the health of the diagnosed but also impacts the entire family. Children whose parents are diagnosed with cancer are filled with numerous cancer-related questions. This program aims to broaden the support to those children by providing them with a one-on-one mentoring relationship.

LUNCH PALS & LUNCH PALS +

Our school-based mentoring program, Lunch Pals, provides mentors to children identified by the school who may demonstrate poor social skills, lack of confidence, behavioral issues, inappropriate attention seeking behaviors, or lack of interest in school. Mentors provide a listening ear to children over their lunch time every other week. Lunch Pals+ provides mentors to children with disabilities.

PEN PALS

Pen Pals matches a student with a Mentor for the school-year where they hand-write letters back and fourth! Pen Pals supports children at a critical time as they develop their academic skills, self-confidence, and self-concept. Students boast a 63% improvement in reading and 69% improvement in writing.
